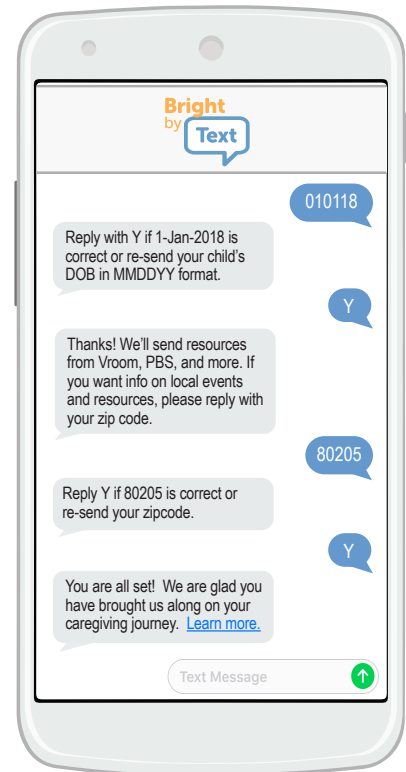
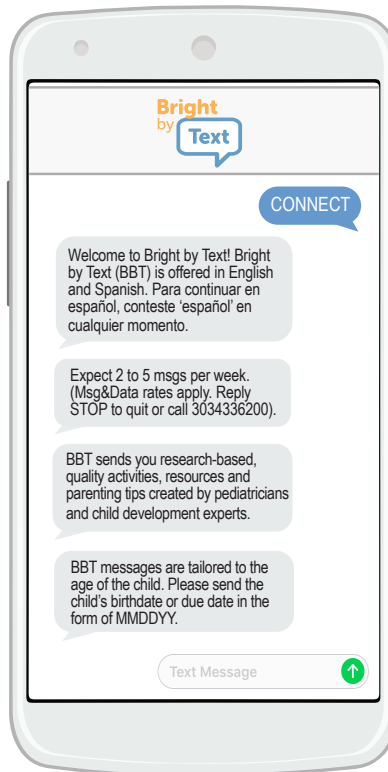
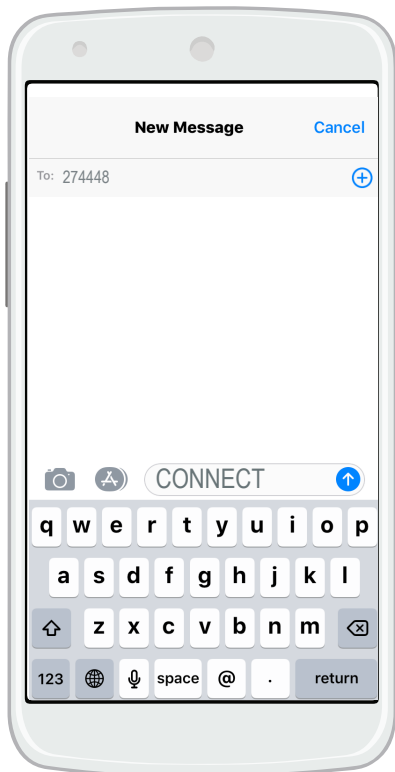
It is a **FREE texting service** providing educational, developmentally appropriate activities, games and resources for parents and caregivers of children under eight.

How to sign up

Text **CONNECT** to **274448** then follow the prompts to enter your child's birthdate and zip code to receive 2-4 new educational activities, games and resources a week!



FAQ

Will it cost anything?

The service is free, but standard text and data fees may apply. Check with your messaging service provider for more information.

How many messages will I receive?

On average, you will receive 2-4 messages per week, per child. You will receive about 2-3 national messages from **Bright by Text** and 1-2 messages from our local partners.

What do I do if I have more than one child?

Register each child separately and receive information relevant to their ages and stages.

If I sign-up, will PBS NC add me to other contact lists?

No. Your contact information will only be used to deliver messages provided by **Bright by Text**. PBS NC cannot track users beyond the age of the registered child and your zip code.

If I decide I no longer want to receive messages, can I opt out?

Yes, you can opt out any time – but we hope you will try it for a while. Text STOP to 274448.

What if I change phone numbers?

If you change phone numbers, you will need to re-register with your new phone number.

Can I tell others about this service?

Yes! Our goal is to provide resources and create strong outcomes for children.
