

THE SEESAW SCOOP



Bump Up Your Whole-Group Instruction Time

Did you know that you can create interactive activities for students to do in Seesaw DURING your whole-group instruction to keep the whole class engaged? For example, if you are talking about vocabulary words, you could create an assignment for students that has each vocabulary word on its own slide. After you discuss each word as a class, have students write and/or draw what the word means. Or as you ask comprehension questions about your read aloud text, have each question on its own slide. Have students write and/or record themselves answering the question. This gives every child the opportunity to respond. You could make it fun by having students ‘whisper the answer to their iPad’.


