Learn required skills to earn the certification of Electrocardiagram Technician (EKG) from the American Society of Phlebotomy Technicians (ASPT).
Upon successful completion you earn one (1) Sandhills Promise Credit.



Hoke County High School students who graduate having completed four Sandhills Community College dual enrollment courses will pay no tuition at the college for the two years immediately following high school graduation. Students must meet eligibility requirements.

Successful students earn high school credit, state or national industry entry level careers, potential crosswalks to SCC curriculum programs and Sandhills Promise credit.



Promise

Learn about robot operations and programming. With hands-on learning, students will utilize the same robots and software used in the industry, including the offline programming software RobotStudio. Upon successful completion of this class, students earn their ABB Robotics credential. This class prepares you for a career as a Robotics Technician.

Prerequisites Interested students should speak to the high school CCP counselor, Mrs. Leslie Baldwin, to discuss prerequisites related to this class.

Successful completion of this class earns you two (2) Sandhills Promise Credits.
